In 1852 the leader of that movement gave his services to Ireland, and from the foundation of the Catholic University we may date the emancipation of Irish history from the withering influence of the infidel and Protestant tradition. In 1864 Bishop Moran, then residing at Rome, brought out his Essays on the Early Irish Church. Just six years before that time, in 1860, O Curry, under the inspiration of Cardinal Newman, had...
